Guidelines for publishing material

- The Technology Forum Terms of Reference allows subgroups to share or publish their work on their own websites or platforms, **provided prior permission is sought from the Bank**.
- The following are conditions that must be met for publication:
 - There should be no mention of Bank involvement in, or association with, the publication.
 - There should be no suggestion that the publication is part of, or related to, the CBDC Tech Forum.
 - Reference may be made to the Bank's external publications, provided this does not infringe the conditions above.
- The Bank will review each proposed publication to check that the conditions above have been met before granting permission to publish.
- Members should seek agreement from <u>all</u> subgroup members before publishing or proposing to
 publish material from their subgroup discussions. The Bank will not arbitrate any disagreements
 between members.
 - Where work is jointly created within the subgroups, members may have joint ownership in the Intellectual Property (IP) and it is for members to agree the use of the work. Prior work members continue to own any pre-existing IP brought to the subgroup remains the domain of its owner.
